- Take a photo of the item and a photo of the serial number on the item.



- Open a new email, address to MyProperty@CitrusHeights.net, place your name and driver license or identification number in the subject line. Attach the photos of your property.

The Citrus Heights Police Department is offering to store your serial numbers for you for free. Serial numbers are important to provide the police department when your items become lost or stolen so they can be entered into a system. Whenever the serial numbers are run in this system, they will come back as lost or stolen and your chances of recovering your lost or stolen items will be much greater. The police can also arrest the person in possession of your stolen property when the system message comes back as listing that serialized item as stolen. If you do become a victim of burglary and you have participated in this program, make sure to tell the officer that you participated and emailed your serialized property to myproperty@citrusheights.net.
