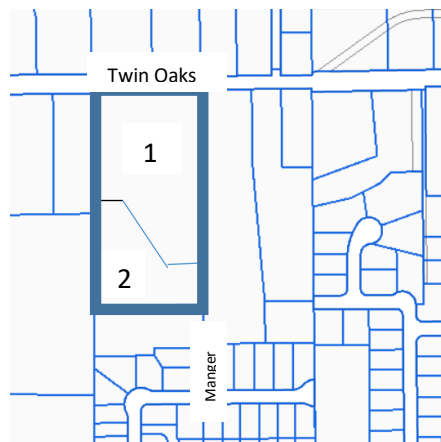

**Project Name:** Parcel Map

**Project Location:** 8020 Twin Oaks Ave (APN # 216-0110-009-0000)

**Project Description:** Subdivide an existing 5-acre parcel into two lots (3.38 and 1.62 acres) with access to the new parcel from Manager Way.

**Environmental Determination:** The project is Categorically Exempt from CEQA per Section 15315 (Minor Land Divisions) of the California Environmental Quality Act.

If you challenge the action of the **Planning Commission** on this matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Department at, or prior to the Public Hearing.
